PRIVATE PRAYER

We could open this church building for private prayer – but we won't.

Why not? Because if you came here to pray we'd have to:

- Make you wash or sanitise your hands at the door.

- Ask you if you had covid symptoms, underlying health problems, had a flu jab or feel unwell (and turn you away if the answer to any of those was "Yes").

- Sit on a bench watching the birds.
- Walk along the sea front,

and talk to God just as easily.
